## Getting Grounded in Teacher Leadership

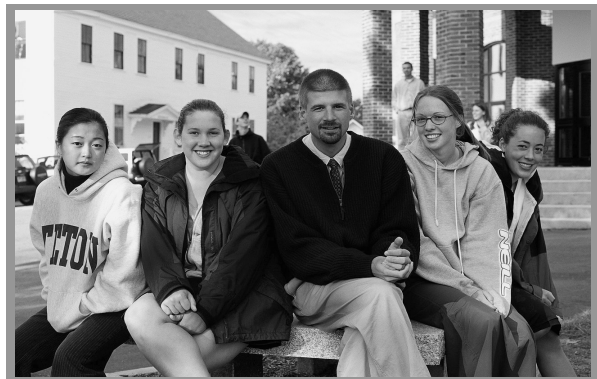
