Knowledge

- Know what kinds of coaching build what kinds of teacher thinking
- Discuss how reflection on practice can impact teacher's effectiveness in the classroom
- Distinguish between coaching behaviors that move teachers to higher levels of thinking and those that do not
- Describe adjustments that can be made for coaching situations in order to be more culturally responsive
